7. WIND TUNNEL

- Flyspot is the most modern wind tunnel in the world, created using the technology of the industry leader - the German company Indoor Skydiving Germany GmbH
- Maximum speed: 320 km / h - Flyspot is the fastest wind tunnel in the world
- The octagonal flight chamber measures 4.2 meters in diameter and 17 meters in height. The glass part is 4.5 meters high.
- Thanks to the reinforced concrete structure, the tunnel achieves enormous power and at the same time remains silent and the air flows are laminar
- The patented tunnel cooling system based on air exchangers allows us to work continuously regardless of external conditions and gives us full control over the temperature in the tunnel to ensure fully comfortable conditions for athletes.

14. ORGANIZATIONAL INFORMATION

Pre-competition training available for EUR 450 /h.

A sports license is not required to participate in the competition. Freestyle riders are required to send a video according to the FAI regulations: Freestyle CR 2019: 5.2.1:

5.2.1.1 Performers must deliver the order of the Compulsory Sequences (for both Compulsory Rounds) to the Chief Judge before the beginning of the competition.

5.2.1.2 Performers must deliver a video (without music) of their Free Routine(s) to the Chief Judge at least 48 hours before the start of the competition. (Performers may optionally include a written list of elements and/or present and explain their Free Routine(s) to the panel.) Each Performer may submit multiple Free Routines, but, during the competition, may submit a change only one time.

15. SAFETY/EQUIPMENT

All participants are required to have a helmet and equipment that complies with FAI Sporting Code 5 2021.

- Tunnel with exposed metal parts is not allowed.
- In the event of entering the tunnel with exposed metal elements, despite the warning, the Organizer may impose a financial penalty on the competitor for any damage to the tunnel equipment.
- The plastic camera mounts should be removed or secured from the helmet before entering the tunnel.
- If the helmet includes plastic grips and the competitor is aware of the risks of flying with additional equipment, this should be approved in writing by the designated Flyspot instructor.
- Flyspot reserves the right to prohibit any competitor with non-standard equipment from entering the tunnel.
- It is recommended that riders carry their own weight belts. Flyspot has a limited number of rental lanes.

16. INSURANCE AND LIABILITY

- Competitors are required to have individual health insurance and third party liability insurance
- The organizer is not responsible for any health detriment, injuries or injuries of competitors sustained during the competition.
- Competitors are responsible for their personal belongings and sports equipment

17. REGULATIONS AND RULES

All participants are required to have a helmet and equipment that complies with the FAI 2021 Sporting Code.

Competitions will be conducted and assessed in accordance with the current FAI 2021 regulations, with the exception of the following local / internal rules:

1. Each team is obliged to put on the helmets the players indicated by the organizer and in accordance with the instructions provided by the organizer received during registration:

a. RFID tags

b. Starting numbers

A team that does not comply with this requirement will be awarded zero points for the relevant round. This principle is not subject to the right to protest.

2. Each team is responsible for managing the time and has enough time to prepare and execute the flight. A team entering the tunnel too early, before the time indicated for it, will receive zero points in the given round. This principle is not subject to the right to protest.

3. The three-member jury will delegate one who is present. The other two members remain in mobile contact when decisions are needed.

4. FS 2-way Advanced is assessed according to internal Flyspot rules available on the Flyspot Open website.
