4. JUDGING

Judging systems:

Indoor FS4, VFS, FS2, AE: InTime Scoring System Dynamic Flying, Solo Speed: DynamR

Judges:

Chief Judge - Agnieszka Sobczyńska (FI). Judging panel in hybrid format.

Chief Judge, Event Judges, AE and Dynamic judges present on at the tunnel, while other judges remotely. Possibility to change the composition of the AE panel to a hybrid one, depending on the number of registered competitors.

The full panel of judges will be announced during the Competitor meeting and briefing.

5. JURY

6. TUNNEL

Technical data:

- Flyspot is one of the most modern wind tunnels in the world, created using the technology of the industry leader - the German company Indoor Skydiving Germany GMbH
- Maximum speed: 320 km / h
- The octagonal flight chamber measures 4.2 metres in diameter and 17 metres in height. The glass part is 4.5 metres high.
- Thanks to the reinforced concrete structure, the tunnel achieves enormous power and at the same time remains silent, and the air flows are laminar
- The patented tunnel cooling system based on air exchangers allows us to work continuously regardless of external conditions and gives us full control over the temperature in the tunnel to ensure fully comfortable conditions for competitors.

9. ACCESS / TRANSPORT TO FLYSPOT KATOWICE

BY PLANE

From Katowice-Pyrzowice Airport (KTW): Taxi or Uber: about 30 minutes via S1 \rightarrow A1.

Public transport: direct AP bus to Katowice, then taxi.

From Kraków-Balice Airport (KRK):

Taxi or Uber: about 50-60 minutes via A4.

Public transport: train Kraków Airport – Katowice Główne, then taxi.

BY TRAIN

From Katowice Główny railway station you can reach Flyspot Katowice by taxi or Uber (about 15 minutes).

BY CAR

You can park your car in the free parking lot in front of the Flyspot Katowice building.

19. SAFETY & EQUIPMENT

- All participants are required to have a helmet and equipment that complies with FAI Sporting Code 5 2025.
- Entering with exposed metal parts is not allowed.

- In case of entering the tunnel with exposed metal elements, despite the warning, the
 Organizer may impose a financial penalty on the competitor for any damage to the tunnel
 equipment.
- The plastic camera mounts should be removed from the helmet or secured before entering the tunnel.
- If the helmet includes plastic grips and the competitor is aware of the risks of flying with additional equipment, this should be approved in writing by the designated Flyspot instructor.
- Flyspot reserves the right to prohibit any player with non-standard equipment from entering the tunnel.
- It is recommended that competitors carry their own weight belts. Flyspot has a limited number of rental weight belts.

20. INSURANCE AND CIVIL LIABILITY

All competitors are required to have individual health insurance and liability insurance.

The organiser shall not be liable for any harm, injury or damage to competitors sustained during the competition.

Competitors are responsible for their personal belongings and equipment.

21. COMPETITION RULES

All participants are required to wear a helmet and equipment that complies with the FAI Competition Rules.

The competition shall be conducted and judged in accordance with the current FAI General and Competition rules, except for the following local/internal rules:

- Each team is obliged to put on the helmets of the competitors indicated by the organiser and in accordance with the instructions given by the organiser received at registration team number stickers
- 2. If a team does not comply with this requirement will be awarded zero points for the relevant round. This is not subject to protest.
- 3. Each team is responsible for managing the time and has enough time to prepare and execute the flight. A team entering the tunnel too early or too late, not in the right order, will receive zero points in the given round. This is not subject to protest.

FS 2way Advanced is judged according to internal Flyspot rules available on the Flyspot Open website, rules implemented in 2022.
